Internship - Landscape Architect / Urban Forestry Paid Internship

Village of Weston, Wisconsin

Job Description: This internship is a limited term employment under the supervision of the Park Superintendent and Park Maintainers. Intern will be responsible for assisting Village Park staff with the overall appearance and maintenance of the Village's green-space. Examples of Work Performed: 1. Plant and maintain village greenery, which would include turf, shrubs, annual plantings, flower beds and trees. This may include brushing, pruning, trimming, fertilizing, weeding, mulching and watering of plant materials. 2. Maintain grass areas in all parks and public places. Operate all equipment associated with grass maintenance. 3. Follow turf and shrub maintenance plans. The intern position in 2007 will be 50% funded by an Urban Forestry Grant received through the W.D.N.R. and therefore the intern will be responsible to collect information on the emerald ash borer and gypsy moth and prepare articles regarding these pests to be included in the Village Newsletter. This individual will also be required to hold one public meeting to address the public and give a presentation regarding these two nuisances. Both of these projects will be for public awareness and intern applicants may want to check with their professors to see if school credit would be available for this project.
