All proposals must be **received** at the above address by **September 15, 2006 at 3:00 p.m.** Proposals will become part of the official files of the City of Selma and cannot be returned. No late bids will be accepted, no exceptions.

Project Description

A. Introduction

The City of Selma is seeking proposals from qualified companies to replace existing Playground Equipment. The City of Selma has allocated \$45,000.00 to be used for the purchase of Playground Equipment and Installation Costs.

B. Background

The City of Selma's project budget is \$45,000.00 for the purchase of playground equipment, installation, including taxes and freight. The proposals need to include installation costs.

C. Project Objectives

The City of Selma has an area already designated for Playground Equipment. The Playground Equipment being requested should be usable for ages 3 and up. The City of Selma minimum requirements for the Playground Equipment must include the following:

- Play Equipment Apparatus (including climbing, slides, etc...)
- T-frame swing (Belt Seat and Tot Swing)
- Benches (2) with back (in ground)
- Surface Ground ADA Requirements
- Possible Reconfiguration of Surface Curbing (Cement curbing already exists.)

(Playground Equipment color will be decided upon after the approval of the Bid Request)

D. Award

Award of the purchase contract is in the sole discretion of the City Council. The Council will determine which proposal best meets the objectives and needs of recreational use within the limited funds available. The right to make no award is reserved.

E. Conclusion

The City of Selma realizes each community's playground equipment and design is unique. The minimum requirements, age group and area are provided in the Project Objectives. The City of Selma will evaluate each proposal carefully and through the Recreation and Community Services Commission, recommend their choice to the City Council for approval.
